



SeaTac, WA: Basic Population Demographics

The source of these January 2017 estimates is Environics Analytics, which recently acquired Claritas and its data resources after a long-standing alliance. Summary:

SeaTac's population has grown steadily since the 2000 Census, and is projected to grow 5.06% by 2022, a rate higher than the USA rate of 3.77%, but lower than King County's 7.46%. SeaTac has considerable ethnic diversity. Only 51.76% of the age 5+ population reportedly spoke only English at home; some 13.90% spoke Spanish at home, considerably higher than King County's 6.82%, but only somewhat higher than the USA's overall 13.16%. Languages spoken at home also included Asian/Pacific, Indo Indo-European, and other languages.

There were proportionately more males than females as compared with King County and USA percentages. The average reported age was bit young at 36.9 yrs. while King County's was 38.9 yrs.; the USA's was 39.1 yrs. Also notable was a higher percentage of age 15+ "never married" than for King County and the USA.

Key Findings: As of January 2017, a total of 11.6% of the residents were age 65 or older, lower than King County's 13.26%, and the USA's overall 15.46%). Both the median age (half above and half below) and average age of SeaTac residents were younger than for King County and the USA overall.

Key Findings: Notable below is that the total of 36.51% of the population age 15+ “never married” breaks out into 21.93% males and 14.58% females. As of January 2017, a total of 31.37% of the city’s residents age 25+ years had (only) a High School diploma (King County 16.45%, USA 27.83%). Some 13.87% had a Bachelor’s degree (King County 29.43%, USA 18.43%) but no higher degree; 5.17% had a Master’s degree; a total of 1.24% had a professional school degree or a Doctorate.
