 - 1. Growth management strategy
 - Urban Center
 - Station Areas and City Center as higher density nodes
 - General Growth

<u>Summary of Draft Amendments</u>

- 2. Healthy, Equitable and Connected Communities:
 - Includes policies from Safe and Complete Streets Plan/Access To Corner Stores Policies endorsed by City Council
 - Aligns with Growing Transit Communities
 Compact
- 3. Land Use Descriptions moved in from Land Use Background Report:
 - Restated as policies to guide zoning decisions
 - Improves internal alignment

<u>Summary of Draft Amendments</u>

- Policy language updated/restated
- Policy language standardized with active verbs
- Discussion sections removed if unnecessary
- Improved "wayfinding"
 - Element Table of Contents added
- Factual updates and other language clarifications

Remaining Question

- Delete Mobile Home Park Land Use Designation?
 - Remaining mobile home parks designated Residential High, Residential High/Mixed Use, Commercial High
 - Zoned consistent with those designations
 - "Grandfathered" under pre-incorporation
 King County permits
