## Goal 1.1 – Serve the SeaTac Community

Existing policies with city-wide application moved in from other elements

- Policy 1.1A from Housing Element
  - Addresses public engagement for all planning, major project work
- Policy 1.1C from Human Services Element
  - Serve as model employer

New Policies address internal communication, coordination and monitoring

## Goal 1.2 – Consistency & Coordination

- Maintain Plan's Consistency with GMA, Regional & County Plans
- Remain true to City values and aspirations
- Coordinate with adjacent jurisdictions
- Maintain Plan's internal consistency
  - Consistency with implementing regulations
