

The City of SeaTac is Looking for Applicants for the Association of Washington Cities (AWC) Center for Quality Communities Scholarship Fund

SeaTac, Washington (January 26, 2015) - The City of SeaTac is now accepting applications for the AWC Center for Quality Communities Scholarship fund. The scholarship is available through a statewide competitive process for students who are actively engaged in their city government and/or community and plan to attend post-secondary school in fall 2015.

To be eligible, a student must be graduating from high school, home school or receiving a GED in spring/summer 2015; live in SeaTac; plan to continue their education at an accredited post-secondary institution in the 2015-2016 academic year on a half-time or more basis; and been involved with a city government or with a community/school leadership activity.
