# **Citizen Advisory Committee Vacancies**

The City has immediate vacancies on the Community Building Committee and Human Services Advisory Committee. These committees serve in an advisory capacity to the City Council, assisting in decision-making and the setting of City policies.

The Community Building Committee serves in an advisory capacity to the City Council and will research best practices, foster communications and act as a sounding board for projects and programs. Committee members will serve two-year terms. You must be 18 years or older to apply. It's a great opportunity to make a positive impact! Meetings are held on the second Monday of the month at SeaTac City Hall at 5:30 PM. Applications for the Community Building Committee will be accepted until Friday, February 27.

The Human Services Advisory Committee makes reports and recommendations to the City Council concerning human services issues, including the following: review and recommend human services needs assessments and updates; develop recommendations for the City Council on priorities of needs within the community; review and recommend human services plans and policies, including the human services element of the City's comprehensive plan; evaluate funding requests; and review City actions which may affect the accessibility or quality of human services available to the City's residents. Meetings are held the third Monday of the month at 5:30 PM at SeaTac City Hall. Applications for the Human Services Advisory Committee will be accepted until Friday, March 13.
