## Construction Alert

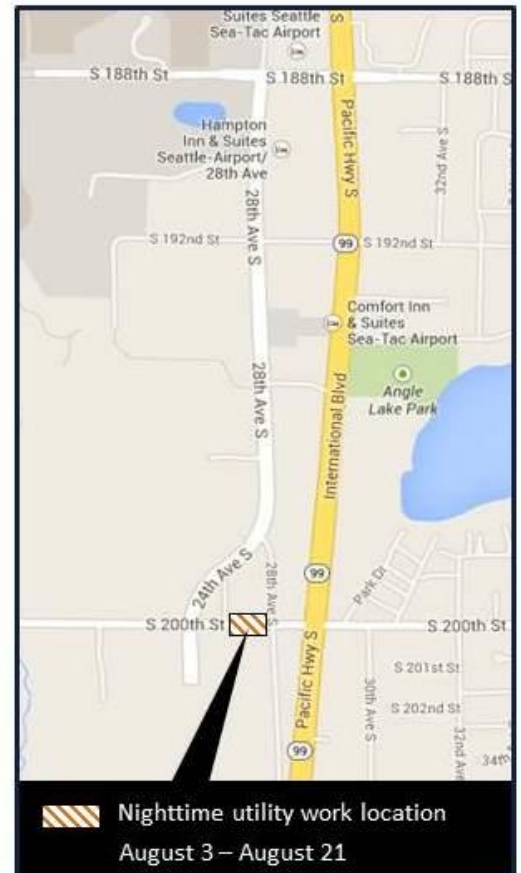
## Nighttime construction on South 200th Street between 26th Avenue S and 28th Avenue S begins in August

Beginning as early as Monday, August 3, Puget Sound Energy crews will be relocating electrical utilities along the northern side of South 200th Street between 26th Avenue South and 28th Avenue South.

The City of SeaTac has approved a temporary noise variance to allow this work to occur between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. to minimize impacts to the traveling public. The work is expected to take approximately three weeks.

### What to expect:

- South 200th Street will remain open in both directions during this work. There may be lane closures, traffic shifts, and short motorist delays. Flaggers will be onsite to help direct motorists around the work.
- Noise from equipment operations (trucks, excavator, bulldozer)
- Lighting to illuminate the work area
- No electrical service disruptions are expected with this work.
