## Construction Alert

August 12, 2015

## Road construction near the future S 200th Link Extension continues this fall

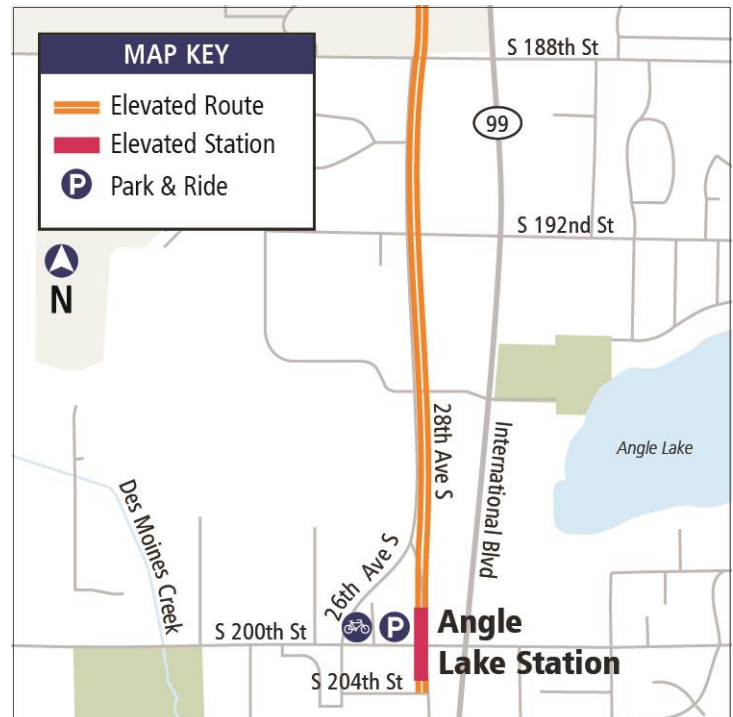
Crews building the Angle Lake Station are entering the restoration phase of the project. This phase involves streetscape improvements on roadways near the future S 200th Link Extension.

Roadway construction is under way and will continue this fall. Streetscape improvements will include:

- **New bike lanes** along both sides of S 200th Street between 26th Avenue S and International Boulevard
  - **New sidewalks** along 28th Avenue S between S 204th Street and S 188th Street
  - **Lighting improvements** along S 200th Street, 26th Avenue S, and 28th Avenue S near the station
  - **Repaving and striping** along S 200th Street between the vicinity of Des Moines Creek and International Boulevard and along 28th Avenue S between S 204th Street and the 26th Avenue S/28th Avenue S intersection
  - **Roadway improvements** along 26th Avenue S between S 200th Street and S 188th Street
- Other improvements include a new traffic light at the 28th Avenue S and S 200th Street intersection and new crosswalks.

### What to expect:

- Frequent lane closures, traffic shifts, and motorist delays. Flaggers will be onsite during major traffic changes to help direct motorists around the work. **Notices will be distributed to announce any future road closures.**
- Noise from digging up existing sections of roadway and equipment operations (trucks, excavators, bulldozers, vector trucks, sawcutting equipment)
- Night work and lighting to illuminate the work area
- Truck traffic delivering materials and hauling materials offsite



- Changes in access to a few local businesses in the area. Look for signage to help direct you to business parking. ***Businesses are open -- Please support local businesses during construction.***

Opening in 2016 will be quick, all-day Link service between Angle Lake Station and Sea-Tac Airport, downtown Seattle and the University of Washington.
