Agenda Bill #3694; A Motion authorizing the City Manager to execute an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with Highline Water District (HWD) for water main replacement in conjunction with the 37^{th} and 40^{th} Avenues South Sidewalk Project

Summary: HWD desires to replace 1,075 linear feet of existing water main on 40th Avenue South from South 170th to 166th Streets. Combining HWD's water main work with the City's sidewalk project will minimize disruption to the neighborhood and traveling public. The project also benefits from savings in sharing costs associated with traffic control, erosion control, and construction surveying. The District will reimburse the City for 100% of the actual water main construction cost. In addition, a 10% fee is also assessed for the construction management of the District's work.

This Motion has no net financial impact to the City. The full cost of construction and management of the District's work is estimated at \$254,721.64. These costs will be reimbursed by HWD.

Civil Engineer II Khlevnoy reviewed the agenda bill summary.

Councilmember Fernald arrived at this point in the meeting.
