

#### Site Selection

- Mountains to Sound
- GIS Technology
- Assessed 163 public properties



#### Site Selection - Criteria

- Land ownership and management
- Canopy cover
- Growing area
- Land use
- Topography
- Soil suitability
- Transportation access
- Neighborhood demographics

#### Site Selection

- Identified 39 sites with a total of 0.5 acres or more of potentially cultivatable area
- 5 sites met garden suitability requirements
  - Sufficient Garden Area & Compatible Land Use

| 4 | Glacier                              | Adjacent to site #1                         | Owned by Highline schools    |
| 5 | North SeaTac Park<br>Sites           | Near North SeaTac Park                      | Owned by Port of Seattle     |

#### What is nearby?

- SeaTac Community Center, Cascade View Elementary School, Tukwila Pantry-Food Bank, corner of 24th Ave S and S 138th ST. Botanical Gardens
- . Located behind Glacier High School, the blue, white and grey building is the school.
- . The entrance is on 138th St.
- . 2 blocks from the bus stop on Military Rd and S. 138th (#128)
- . Mostly home owners around
- Between Military Rd and 24th on the comer with the SeaTac Community Center. Two blocks from the Tukwila Pet Hospital.




SPU Site is next to the Glacier Site.




White circle is approximate garden size.

#### **Key Site Characteristics**

- . Owned by the City of Seattle
- . Vacantland
- . 0.6 acres for a garden
- . 2 blocks from a bus stop
- . Low levels of soil contamination (Arsenic)
- . Low income neighborhood
- . NO WATER AVAILABLE on-site for irrigation
