

South 200th Link Extension


Roadway restoration continues along S 200th Street New traffic pattern begins as early as Monday, Dec. 28*

Crews building the Angle Lake Station are restoring S 200th Street between 26th Avenue S and International Boulevard. Crews have been working on the south side of the road this fall to relocate utilities, build new sidewalks, install lighting and repave the road.

Beginning as early as Monday, Dec. 28*, crews will begin working on the north side of the road. Crews will maintain at least one lane of traffic in each direction along S 200th Street during this work. Once the north side of S 200th Street is complete, crews will repave, stripe, and re-open all lanes to motorists. New signage and traffic signals will also be installed this winter.

This work is expected to take approximately three months to complete and is weather dependent.

Crews will be working on the north side of S 200th Street. Traffic will be shifted to the south. There are two detours associated with this work. Refer to the back page for more information.

What to expect:

- 24/7 lane closures along S 200th Street.
- Potential motorist delays on S 200th Street and International Boulevard.

No left turn from eastbound S 200th Street to northbound International Boulevard

Motorists heading eastbound on S 200th Street from the vicinity of Des Moines Memorial Drive will not be able to turn left onto International Boulevard to head north.

Detour: From S 200th Street heading east, turn left onto 26th Avenue S heading north, turn right onto S 188th Street, then turn left onto International Boulevard to head north.

• 🕅 No left turn from northbound International Boulevard to westbound S 200th Street

Motorists heading northbound on International Boulevard will not be able to turn left onto S 200th Street to head west.

Detour: From International Boulevard heading north, turn left onto S 192nd Street, turn left onto 28th Avenue S, then turn right onto S 200th Street to head west.

- Work will typically occur during daytime hours between 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
- Some pedestrian detours may be necessary. Signage will help pedestrians get around the work.
- Noise from digging up existing sections of roadway and equipment operations (trucks, excavators, bulldozers, vactor trucks, sawcutting equipment).
- Night work and lighting to illuminate the work area.

Businesses are Open

There may be changes in access to a few local businesses in the area. Please look for signage to help direct you to business parking.

Opening in 2016 will be quick, all-day Link service between Angle Lake Station and Sea-Tac Airport, downtown Seattle and the University of Washington.
