



Council Actions from January 5, 2016 Special Council Meeting

SeaTac, WA (January 6, 2016) – The following Council actions were taken at the January 5, 2016 Special Council Meeting:

Rick Forschler was elected as Mayor of the City of SeaTac through 2017.

Michael Siefkes was elected as Deputy Mayor of the City of SeaTac through 2017.

A Resolution #16-001 removing Todd Cutts from the position of City Manager and suspending Todd Cutts from the duties of City Manager was passed and became effective January 5, 2016.

A Resolution #16-002 designating Mary Mirante Bartolo as Acting City Manager was passed and became effective January 5, 2016.

Incorporated in February 1990, the City of SeaTac is located approximately midway between the cities of Seattle and Tacoma. The City of SeaTac is 10 square miles in area and has a population of 28,251. The City is a vibrant community, economically strong, environmentally sensitive, and people-oriented. The City boundaries surround the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, (approximately 3 square miles in area) which is owned and operated by the Port of Seattle.
