CALL TO ORDER: The Senior Citizen Advisory Committee meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Minutes dated December 15, 2015 were approved as written.

SEATAC CAFÉ UPDATE:

The 2015 purchases for the Café were reviewed. These included the cart, colander, cutting boards, utensils, carafes and silverware.

BAZAAR FINAL TALLY:

The final tally of the 2015 bazaar was presented. Each cost center was reviewed. There was a question why the funds can't be separated from the general city funds. It was explained that the Committee is not a non-profit. There was also a question about the past fundraising areas that were not at this year's bazaar.
