SeaTac, WA (March 17, 2016) – The SeaTac City Council will host a Town Hall Meeting from 6:00-8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 5 at the SeaTac Community Center located at 13735 24th Avenue S. in SeaTac.

Attendees at the meeting will have the opportunity to ask questions of the SeaTac City Council. If time limits the number of questions the Council can respond to, the public may choose to receive a return phone call from a Councilmember after the meeting.

Donny Payne, the Interim City Manager commented: “With a newly constituted City Council that is emphasizing open government and transparency, we believe now is the time for the community to have a chance to communicate with their elected officials in an open Town Hall meeting”. About the City of SeaTac:

Incorporated in February 1990, the City of SeaTac is located approximately midway between the cities of Seattle and Tacoma. The City of SeaTac is 10 square miles in area and has a population of 28,251. The City is a vibrant community, economically strong, environmentally sensitive, and people-oriented. The City boundaries surround the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, (approximately 3 square miles in area) which is owned and operated by the Port of Seattle.

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
