



## **City of SeaTac Opens Comprehensive Plan Amendment Process**

**SeaTac, WA (March 30, 2016)** - The City of SeaTac is now providing an opportunity to propose amendments to the Comprehensive Plan, including the comprehensive plan map and any elements (Subarea Plans, Shoreline Master Program, etc.). Final action will be taken by the City Council in November or December of this year.

**Process:** Anyone wishing to propose an amendment to the Comprehensive Plan must submit a Comprehensive Plan Amendment Application, which is available at the SeaTac Permit Center or on the City's website [here](#).

**Application Deadline: 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, June 1, 2016**

**Application Requirements:** All applications must be clearly and completely filled out and filed at the City's Permit Center. The application contains questions that require written responses. City staff will be available to provide assistance and answer questions about the application process.

**Application Fees:** \$2,100.00 (Amendment fee) + \$2,180.00 (SEPA fee)
