Public Comment Period Begins for Sound Transit 3 Draft Plan

Sound Transit is shaping a Sound Transit 3 (ST3) ballot measure for the region's voters to consider in November 2016. ST3 represents the next set of mass transit investments to keep our region moving between and to destinations throughout the region, regardless of weather or traffic.

In summer 2015, almost 25,000 people provided input to the Sound Transit Board of Directors on what projects to consider as candidates for ST3. In August the Board identified projects for further study and on December 4 the results of those studies were released. The studies documented estimated benefits and costs for each project. On March 24, the Board released the ST3 draft plan for public review and comment. View the [draft plan](#) and [take the survey](#) to tell us if this is the right system for the region.
