The City of SeaTac is proud to announce the completion of construction on Fire Station 45 and will be hosting an open house on Saturday, May 21 from 10:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m. located at 3011 S. 200<sup>th</sup> St. The ceremony will begin at 11:30 a.m.

Construction of the new station began in the spring of 2015 and was completed in late April. The new 7,000 square foot facility will provide a modern and efficient space for our firefighters to serve the community for years to come.

“The open house will provide a perfect opportunity for individuals and families to tour the station, meet our firefighters and participate in all of the great activities we have planned.” said Mayor Siefkes. He added: “keeping the station in the Angle Lake area adds another benefit for the current and anticipated growth of this part of the city.”

Several activities for children will be available such as the photo booth and meeting Sparky the Fire Dog. Station, engine and self guided tours will be held and light refreshments will be provided. Parking for the event will be at nearby Madrona Elementary School, 3030 S. 204<sup>th</sup> St., just down the block from the station. A shuttle will bring you to

the fire station and will return you to the school. The shuttle will run from 9:45 a.m. until the end of the event.
