The Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) will have their Mobile Community Services Office (CSO) at SeaTac City Hall. The Mobile CSO unit is staffed by experienced program specialists who are able to determine eligibility for cash, food, and child care subsidy programs. They can issue EBT cards and receive documents. The Mobiles CSO specialists can also determine eligibility for Medicare Savings Programs and Aged, Blind, or Disabled Medicaid.
