Agency Presentations

Kim House, Institute for Family Development family therapist, shared about the PACT program – 3-month, 40 hrs., in-home counseling for families not involved in the CPS system. PACT is based on the HOMEBUILDERS model of family preservation to help families improve family functioning, increase parenting skills, improve children's behavior, and increase family social supports and social connections. At the closure of services, 73% of these families showed significant improvement in family functioning, 92% showed significant improvement in child well-being and behavior, and 83% showed significant improvement in social supports.

Lauren Plitkins, SKC Program Instructor with Literacy Source, provides (ESL) classes and tutoring, computer literacy, workplace basic skills, citizenship classes and naturalization assistance for low income individuals, and GED prep. Class is 4 hours twice a week, for 3 quarters. In 2015, 52 SeaTac learners were served with 142 hours of class. 100% of students report self-sufficiency – better able to advocate for self/family and felt more connected to resources and the community.97% made educational gains.

The Committee read, scored, and asked questions about the first 1/3 of applications.
