Re: Solid Waste Collection Franchise Fee Adjustment

Recology CleanScapes (RCS) is SeaTac's contracted Comprehensive Garbage, Recyclables and Compostables Collection service provider. The RCS Contract started on June 1, 2014 and runs through May 31, 2021.

At the time the contract was executed, it purposefully delayed changes to Drop-box customer charges under the franchise fee of the new contract because at the time the contract went into effect, Drop-box customers would have had both an increased cost from the initial rate increase and a franchise fee. This was deemed to be too much of a cost increase at one time and the drop-box charges were consequently deferred. The contract was specifically structured in anticipation of Drop-box customers being made subject to the franchise fee after a reasonable delay.

The process to add Drop-box charges is included in the Contract under Section 3.3.4, <u>Other Modifications</u>, which states in part:

"Any Adjustment in Contractor charges will coincide with the annual rate adjustment process described in this Section 3.3 (Compensation Adjustments)."

The process date for the annual rate adjustment is addressed in Section 3.3.1 <u>Annual Rate Adjustment</u>, which states in part:

"Rates shall be adjusted annually, beginning January 1, 2016 (the "Adjustment Date").

RCS must provide their Rate Adjustment Statement, calculating the new rates for the next year, to the City for review no later than October 1st prior to the Adjustment Date (January 1st of the next year). Upon City approval of the rate modification, customers are notified in November of the next year's new rates. RCS has an Annual Rate Adjustment based on seventy-five percent (75%) of the change (increase/decrease) in the CPI Index for the most recent twelve (12) month period ending June 30th in the year of the request.

City staff has met with RCS regarding the Drop-box customers and the Franchise Fee. RCS is in agreement to add the Drop-box customers per our contract process. The Drop-box customer base can only be added to the Franchise Fee at the same time as the Annual Rate Adjustment.

As more than 2-years have passed since the subject deferral was put in place, thereby adequately addressing the concern of staggering the cost increases to Drop-box customers, we are moving forward with adding Drop-box charges beginning January 1, 2017. RCS is also in agreement with this timing and amount for drop-box charges. In 2017, it is estimated that drop-box charges will generate between \$5,000 and \$8,000 on a monthly basis, for use by the solid waste fund. The solid waste fund provides the following services:

- Solid Waste Contract administration and oversight;
- Programming related to diversion rates of the City's overall waste stream to King County transfer stations;
- Residential/multifamily/commercial education and outreach addressing proper disposal of solid waste & hazardous waste streams;
- Recycling & resource conservation events.

- 90 days late by August July 1st
 - ➤ Notice of Infraction issued per SMC 5.05.190
 - Fine set by Judge per SMC 5.05.190
- 120 days late by September 1st ➤ 100% of fee penalty

5.05.190 - Engaging in Business without a License or Payment of fee

- Notify the licensee in writing by first class mail, certified mail or personal service that they are operating a business within the City limits without a business license and have thirty (30) days to apply and obtain a business license as specified in SMC 5.05.020.
- ➤ If the licensee fails to respond to the letter within thirty (30) days, the licensee will be subject to a fine of a maximum of \$250, and the City Manager or designee shall follow the procedures for a Notice of Infraction in SMC 1.15.065 and Hearing before the Municipal Court Judge in SMC 1.15.075.



Projected vs. Actual






Actual vs. Projected
