

## The Firs Mobile Home Park Closure

The owner of the Firs Mobile Home Park, located at 20440 International Blvd., is planning to close the park and redevelop the property. Although the State of Washington's Office of Mobile Home Relocation Assistance has primary authority for overseeing park closures, the City of SeaTac also requires an owner to submit a relocation plan for review and approval. This Monday (October 17), the City approved the relocation plan, as it complies with the standards of the SeaTac Municipal Code. Anyone objecting to this action can appeal that decision to the City's Hearing Examiner no later than 5:00 PM on Monday, October 31. Appeals must be filed at the City Clerk's office.

City staff worked to ensure the main body of the relocation plan was accurately translated in Spanish, as the Firs is a predominantly Hispanic community. The owner of the park is obligated to provide a copy of the plan to each park tenant. Once the park owner provides an official notice of intent to close the park with the State of Washington, tenants are given 12 months to relocate.



## Intersection Improvements at Military Road and S. 200th Street
