1. Call to Order	Deputy Mayor Fernald called the meeting to order at 5:01 PM
2. Neighborhood Parking Permit Options	<p><u>X</u> Informational Presentation with Q & A <u>X</u> Recommended Action</p> <p>PW Florendo Cabudol presented background information and showed maps of current and projected problem parking areas. He introduced a plan to request funding for 1) a contracted study to determine process options, fee structures, criteria for determining areas of implementation, identify equipment and administration needs, etc. and 2) to fund a neighborhood parking permit program once the process has been outlined. He and Public Works Director Appleton asked the committee to consider recommending a Decision Card to go before council, in the amount of \$500,000 to fund this program.</p> <p>The proposed plan would allow for implementation in existing problem areas and would be developed as a model that could be implemented in additional problem areas as they develop in other parts of the city, if they meet criteria which will be defined in the process.</p> <p>Moving forward with the process was described as having multiple checkpoints as progress is made. It was noted that the study results and plan development would come before the committee and likely council, multiple times before complete implementation.</p> <p>There was much discussion.</p>

	<p><i>ACTION ITEM: Question for the courts – how much of each ticket, if won in court, goes to City – how are the funds divided?</i></p> <p><i>RECOMMENDATION: The Public Safety and Justice Committee gave approval for Public Works to submit a budget decision card to implement a residential parking permit program. PS&J will move it forward to Council.</i></p>
