Proposed Revisions to Chapter 5.05 - Business Licenses and Regulations



Two Part Project

- Part One – Decrease the amount of time it takes to issue a business license
 - Part Two – Replace Existing Business License Chapter with a Revised and Streamlined Chapter 5.05 Business Licenses & Regulations
- 

Summary of Revisions

- Failure to renew or obtain a business license within the prescribed amount of time will result in a “Notice of Infraction” procedures and a hearing before the Municipal Judge.
 - Applicants have 60 days to renew a business license
 - A 30 day courtesy letter will be mailed to applicant
- 

Summary of Revisions (Cont.)

- Appeal of a Notice of Denial, Suspension or Revocation is heard by the Hearing Examiner and includes procedures for an appeal
 - Penalties for late applications:
 - 25% of fee after 60 days
 - 50% of fee after 90 days
 - 100% of fee after 120 days
- 

New /Renewal Timing

- License Expires April 1
 - Renew by April 30
 - 30 days late May 30 (Courtesy 30 day letter mailed)
 - 60 days late by July 1 (25% of fee penalty)
 - 90 days late by August 1 (50% of fee penalty)
 - 120 days late by September 1 (100% of fee penalty)

Summary of Revisions (Cont.)

- Pawnbrokers remains in the Business License Ordinance
 - Section II – County Provisions Adopted by Reference in the existing ordinance are deleted because King County issues those licenses

Proposed Revision

Draft Ordinance Proposed Revision (5.05.060):

“Non-profit organization recognized by **the** State of Washington and Federal Government **as** 501(c)(3) organizations, **with proper documentation (e.g. IRS Determination Letter or IRS Affirmation Letter)**, are exempted from the requirement to pay fees associated with the issuance of a business license as required by the chapter.....”
