		<ul> <li>Additionally, the HMAC requested that more information be presented on line item expenditures for the proposals with more full explanation of those funds that will be supporting staff costs.</li> <li>In particular how the City of SeaTac staffing support breaks out between the CED Director and the Economic Development Manager. HMAC acknowledged the unusual circumstances for 2017 but desires more information for future requests.</li> <li>The HMAC also wants to see more direct benefit to the City of SeaTac from the NWSO in terms of performances the city and better coordination, partnerships and marketing with local lodging and other tourism organizations.</li> </ul>
