



CITY OF SEATAC APPEALS 2016 JUDGMENT

SeaTac, WA (January 13, 2017) – Today, the City of SeaTac filed its' appellate brief in the K&S Developments, LLC v. City of SeaTac matter at the Washington State Court of Appeals, Division One.

The case pertains to the SeaTac Center which is located at South 154th Street and International Boulevard in the City's South 154th Street Station Area.
