Review Draft of Amended Dangerous Dog and Potentially Dangerous Dog Ordinance (SMC 6.05.110)	<p><u>X</u> Informational Presentation with Q & A <u>X</u> Recommended Action</p> <p>Deputy Mayor Fernald reviewed steps leading to today's discussion. Acting Assistant City Attorney Corsilles presented the draft amended ordinance (6.05.110), which removes breed specific language in Section 1 (A-4) and Section 1 (B-4) everything else remains the same.</p> <p><i>RECOMMENDATION: The committee recommends that staff bring this issue before Council Study Session as a Resolution to Amend the Ordinance; the committee approves the amendment.</i></p>

4. Public Comment	<p>Members of the public were interested in a status update on the Residential Parking Permit Program. They offered anecdotal information about recent parking, loud music, littering and for-hire vehicles which are continuing problems.</p> <p>ACM Scorcio requested that Public Works Director Appleton appear at the March PS&J meeting to provide a comprehensive update on the program; suggested that the meeting be 90 minutes instead of 60.</p>
