**Free Summer Lunch at Angle Lake Park:** The Des Moines Area Food Bank will be providing free lunch for kids in the park beginning Thursday, August 12, between the hours of 1:15 – 1:45 PM. **Update on 2008 Rape Investigation:** The suspect in this investigation was found guilty on all criminal charges and was sentenced to 32.5 years for his actions. There were four victims who testified about this serial rapist who was attacking female prostitutes in the cities of SeaTac and Kent. The suspect was employed as a school bus driver. When he was arrested, the King County Sheriff's Office Special Assault Unit detective was able to get a confession from him and was able to track down valuable evidence showing a timeline for his activity. The criminal charges were Rape in the First Degree, Robbery in the First Degree, Rape in the Second Degree (twice), Robbery in the Second Degree, Assault in the Second Degree (Strangulation), Assault in the Second Degree (Sexual Motivation) and Sexual Misconduct with a Minor.

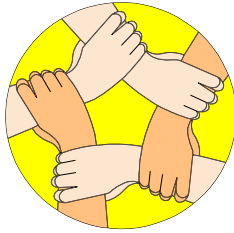
