2. Vacant Positions Update	X Informational Update City Manager, Joe Scorcio, informed the committee of the current vacancies within the City. At this time the City is working to fill many seasonal positions, including lifeguards. Also a few of the vacant positions within the City are part of department realignments and will be filled as those processes are completed. More updates will be given in the future.
3. Position Realignments -Parks, CP & Services - Legal Department	X_Deferred to next A&F Meeting The update regarding these department realignments will be discussed at the June 1 st A&F Meeting.
4. Finance & Systems Department Realignment	X_Recommended for Approval City Manager, Joe Scorcio, presented the attached memo detailing the proposed realignment of the Finance & Systems department. The department currently has two vacancies and two pending retirements which creates an opportunity to adjust the structural organization of the Department. This proposal, if ratified by A&F committee, will reclassify certain positions and begin recruitment as vacancies permit. The memo details these reclassifications and associated compensation. The total

	costs of the new positions will be comparable to, or less than, the combined positions in the 2017-2018 budget with an estimated savings of \$300,000 in the 2017-18 biennium. The committee reviewed this proposal and voted to approve the reclassifications.
5. Ethics for Boards & Commissions	X Recommended for Approval Senior Assistant City Attorney, Mark Johnsen, along with City Manager, Joe Scorcio, presented to the committee the proposed ordinance addressing a code of ethics for board, committee, and commission members. This code pertains to appointed members (non-elected officials). After staff makes a clarification under the definition of "officials", the A&F committee was in favor of this ordinance. It will be presented to the full council at the May 23 rd City Council Meeting.
6. Introduce 2017 Budget Amendment	X Informational Update Finance and Systems Director, Gwen Pilo, along with City Manager, Joe Scorcio, briefly introduced to the committee some budget amendments that will be coming forward at the June 1 st A&F meeting. One request will affect the General Fund, while the other four will affect the Street Fund. These requests will be discussed in detail at a future meeting and staff will ask for a recommendation from the A&F committee at that time.
7. Future Meeting Schedule/Topics	The next A&F Meeting will be held on June 1 st at 3:00PM in Riverton Room 128. Topics will include: Lobby soda machine/coffee machine, Position realignments, Human Services advisory committee funding recommendations, and budget amendments. A Special PS&J/A&F Meeting will be held from 4:30 – 5:30 on June 1 st in Riverton Room 128 to discuss Fire Station 47.
