It serves as a gathering place or "hub" of sorts where individuals, children, and families learn and grow, share support and information, connect and build friendships, access formal and informal resources, and together create a sense of community.

They provide support groups for elders, dropout prevention, ESL, job readiness, early childhood support, WIC, a connections desk, tax prep, and much more. Their therapeutic services are recognized nationally/internationally as they offer counseling, address complex health issues and management and provide specialized treatment to survivors of torture.
