City Manager, Joe Scorcio, explained to the committee the main differences between a Council/Mayor and Elected Mayor/Council form of government. The committee members, along with the Mayor and other councilmembers in attendance, discussed their opinions of a change in the form of government. The committee agreed the City is in a strong position and they do not wish to change anything right now. They also expressed the desire for this change to be initiated by the citizens and not by a councilmember.
