Update on Quiet Skies Coalition	Larry Cripe discussed the current lawsuit between the City of Burien and the FAA. He stated that the Quiet Skies Coalition doesn't have detailed information on the lawsuit because they are not a party to the suit. But Burien is considering allowing coalition access to information. The Coalition is talking to Des Moines and Federal Way and pointed out that there is only a finite amount of air traffic possible at Sea-Tac Airport and it can't keep expanding.
Update on Mayor's Roundtable Meeting	City Manager Scorcio – The members are currently developing a list of topics for the group to work on.
Beautification around	Discussion regarding beautification around the airport. Graham
airport and entrances to City	Trucking – possible example of good landscaping. The Committee discussed possible options including:
	Visuals – Art wraps of utility boxes, street banners.
	Streetscape – Allow for planting, landscaping, street signs, bridges over streets 188 th St. Corridor?
	Wayfinding – Common signage – valuable to pedestrians. Branding/Theme – Create image and replicate.
	It may be prudent to consider a pilot program or test sites to start the process.
Committee Request	Committee formally requested that the City Council budget \$50,000 to \$75,000 for a study of possible beautification options.
Round Robin	Jeff - \$ in the state budget to look at airport impacts. Doug Hill asked for a brief ILA update from the City Manager.
