## **BUSINESS**

Presentation:

Children's Therapy Center

Steve Wright from Children's Therapy Center (CTC) gave a presentation on their services. CTC provides essential therapy services for children with special needs ages birth to 18 years. Offering both home-based and centerbased services, CTC works with family members and care providers to provide physical, occupational, and speech-language therapies. CTC currently has four locations including Burien, Kent, Tacoma and Black Diamond/Maple Valley. Children ages birth to three years are seen within 45 days. There is a waiting list of approximately 500 for ages 3-18 so families have to wait about two years for service.

Review 2019/2020 **Human Services Agency Application Process and** Strategy:

The Committee discussed the process for reviewing and scoring the requests for funding. Judy Williams said that in the past, the Committee read through and scored the applications over three meetings. One third of the applications reviewed at each meeting.
