CALL TO ORDER: The Arts, Culture & Library Advisory Committee meeting was called to order at 5:33 p.m.

OLD BUSINESS: Bruce asked if there was an update on email communication amongst the Committee. So Won informed them Brian Tomisser is still waiting to hear from the Legal Department, and that there is no updates since the last committee meeting.

LIBRARY REPORT: Angelina Benedetti updated the Committee on summer library programs. There is a Young Author's Day on September 15 at the Hilton in SeaTac. Meet the Author event for R.L. Stine, the author of the *Goosebumps* series is on September 14, at Highline Performance Arts Center in Burien. She explained the KCLS Director's Report and Dashboard with KCLS statistics are accessible online. KCLS will be present at the Back to School Fair. SeaTac's Friends of the Library is looking for people in the community to join and become members.
