Wastemobile is in northwest corner of the mall parking  
lot behind Nordstrom Rack.

**Saturdays and Sundays 10 AM to 5 PM**  
Closed Nov 24–25 and Dec 29–30

**BRING:** Oil-based paint, adhesive/glues, pesticides, cleaning products, aerosol cans (*not empty*), propane tanks (*less than 8 gal.*), auto supplies (*antifreeze, brake fluid, gasoline, oil. Separate motor/crank case oil from all other fluids*), thinners/solvents, alkaline household batteries, fluorescent lights.

**DON'T BRING:** Latex paint, electronics, tires, explosives, medical waste, empty containers, garbage, smoke detectors, medications.

Use them up or take them to the wastemobile or a hazardous waste collection site.

# SPECIAL RECYCLING COLLECTION EVENT

No Commercial Loads. No flat bed or dump trucks allowed. **No Yard Debris!**

We reserve the right to refuse oversized, commercial, contaminated, excessive, or unacceptable loads.

**Cash only when fees apply. Residents pay vendors directly.**

Vendors at the event reserve the right to reject any items that do not meet their requirements.



**Latex Paint:** \$1.25/quart, \$2.25/gallon, \$12.25/ five gallons. **Pure Latex Paint Only in original containers. Cash only.**



**CFL Light Bulbs:** Unbroken compact fluorescent light bulbs and tubes. Limit 10 light bulbs per person.



### Clothing & Household Items:

Clothing (all types, sizes) & reusable household items in good condition and useable "as is". **No large furniture or items needing repair.** If not accepted, you must take them back. Donations benefit Northwest Center. Tax receipts available.



**Batteries:** Car, truck and marine lead acid batteries. Household alkaline, rechargeable and button batteries. Please sort large quantities by type.



**Oil, Oil Filters & Antifreeze:** Motor oil, oil filters, diesel fuel, kerosene, antifreeze, transmission & steering fluids. **Do not mix fluids. No gas or brake fluid.**



**Household Refrigerators & Freezers & Small A/C Units: \$35 for each. Cash only**



**Tires:** Auto & motorcycle tires. Tires with rims allowed. Limit 10 per vehicle.



**Electronics:** Cell phones, printers, keyboards, fax machines, scanners, VCRs, CD/DVD players and stereos.



**E-Cycle Items:** Computers & computer monitors, tablet computers, televisions and e-readers.



**Toilets & Porcelain Sinks: Toilet seals, hardware, and base wax ring must be removed - NO EXCEPTIONS.**



**Cardboard:** Please flatten cardboard.



**EPS Styrofoam and Packing Peanuts:** Make sure the EPS (look for the #6 or EPS inside the recycling symbol) is clean and free of any plastic film, cardboard, hard plastics, screws or metal. Dirty or wet EPS will not be accepted. Packing peanuts need to be in a box or bag. **No food containers.**



**Confidential Material Shredding:** LeMay Mobile Shredding will be providing secure document destruction services. Limit: 3 boxes per vehicle.



**Appliances & Scrap Metals:** Washers, dryers, stoves, hot water tanks, BBQ's, lawnmowers, microwaves, auto parts, cast iron, steel. **Remove all gases, fluids or liquids from all items. No car bodies. No items with chemicals.**

### FREE BIO-BAGS

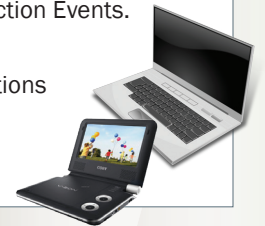
(3 gallon food scrap bags) to first 150 Recology CleanScapes' curbside customers who bring in items for recycling.



### E-CYCLE WASHINGTON

Washington has a FREE recycling program called "E-Cycle Washington" for computers, computer monitors, laptops, portable DVD players and televisions. **Computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program** but will be accepted at SeaTac's Recycling Collection Events.
