Link Light Rail

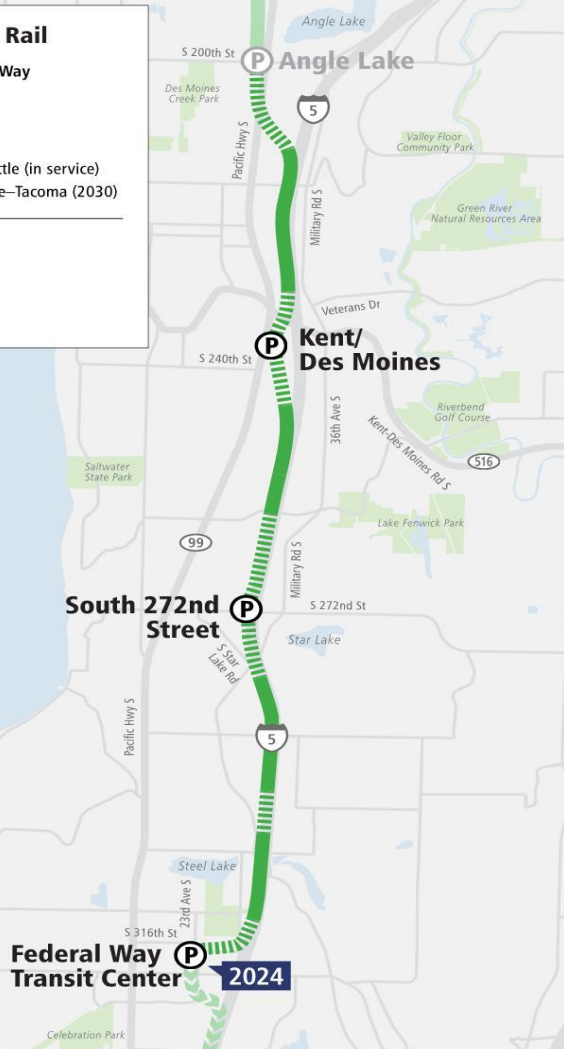
Angle Lake–Federal Way

- Surface
- Elevated

Other service

- Angle Lake–Seattle (in service)
- Federal Way–Fife–Tacoma (2030)

- New station
- Existing station
- New parking
- Existing parking

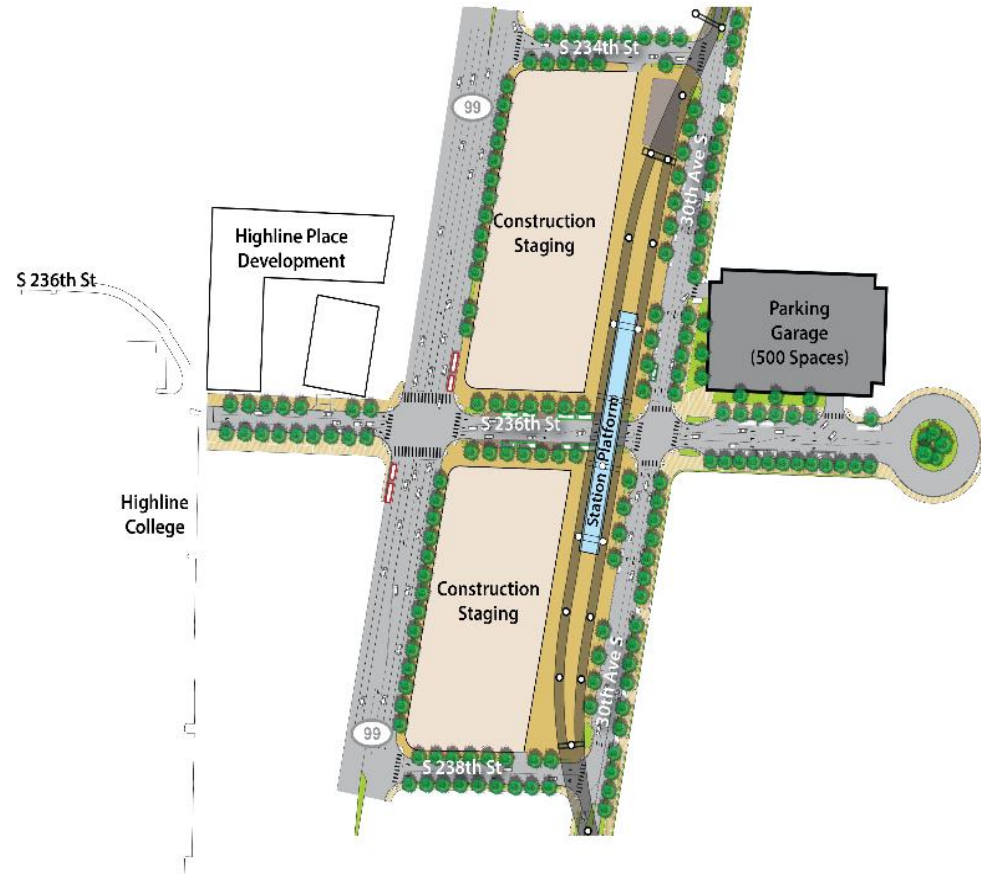


Federal Way Link Extension

Angle Lake to Federal Way

- Length: 7.8 Miles
- Stations: 3 (+3 parking garages)
- Daily Projected Riders: 36,500 (2035)

Kent/Des Moines Station Concept



- New 500 space garage
- Three new, landscaped streets to promote easy access for walking, bicycling and transit
- Two large plaza areas featuring landscaping, seating and public art

South 272nd Street Station Concept

- New 1100 space garage
- Rebuilt portion of S 272 Street improves vehicle/bus access
- Improvements include a pedestrian/bicycle path to the station plaza, connections to the existing freeway bus stop and direct access to the station platform

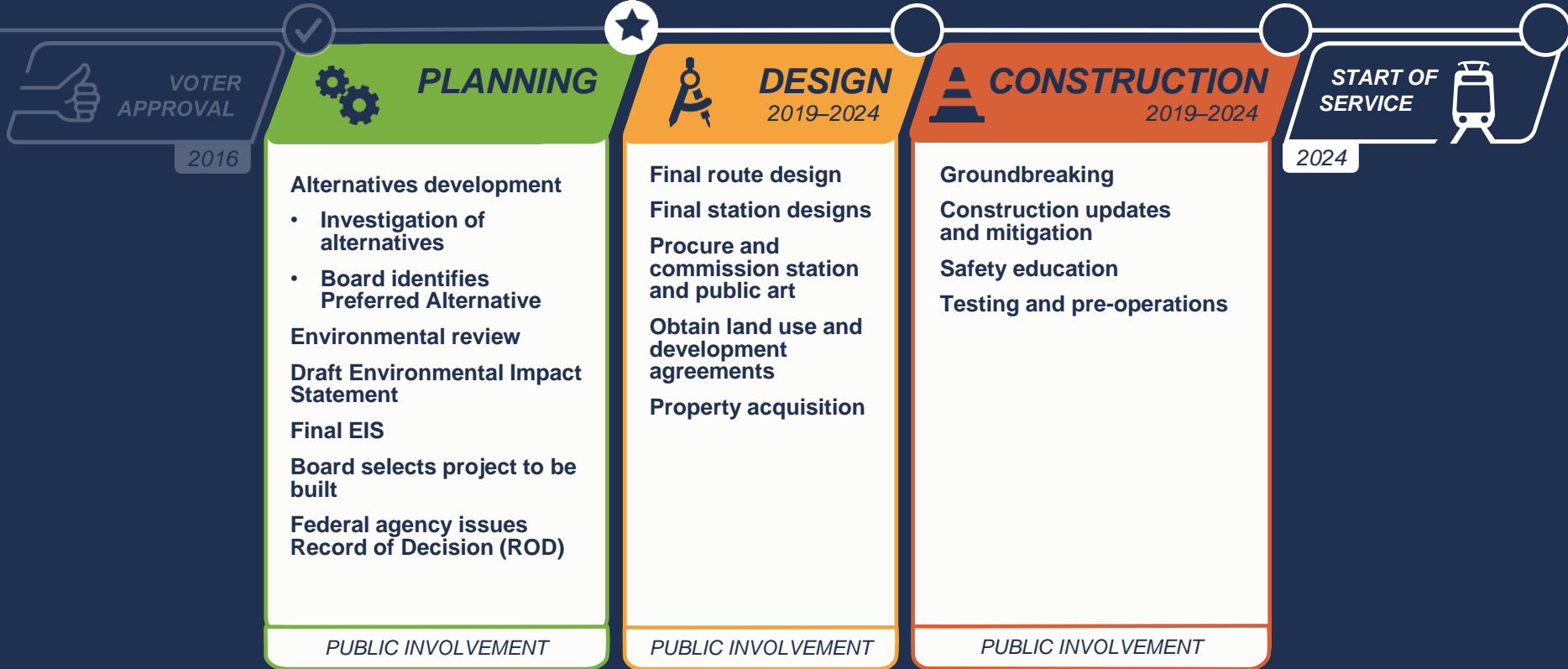


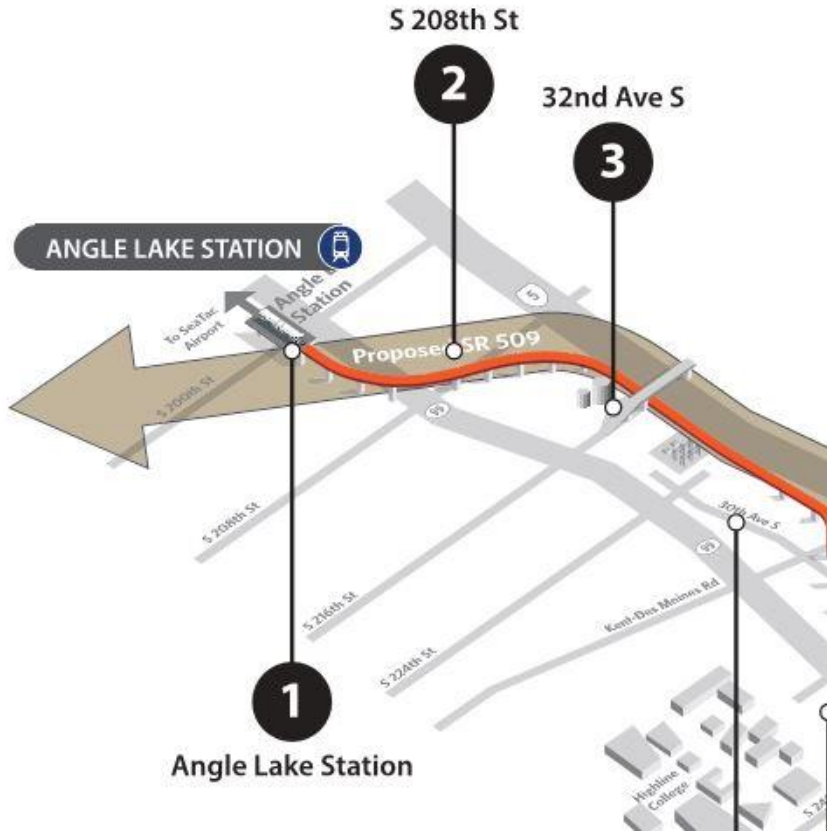
Federal Way Station Concept

- New 400 space garage
- Transit only bus loop for easy transfer to light rail
- New street grid to provide more convenient access and potential for future development



FWLE project timeline

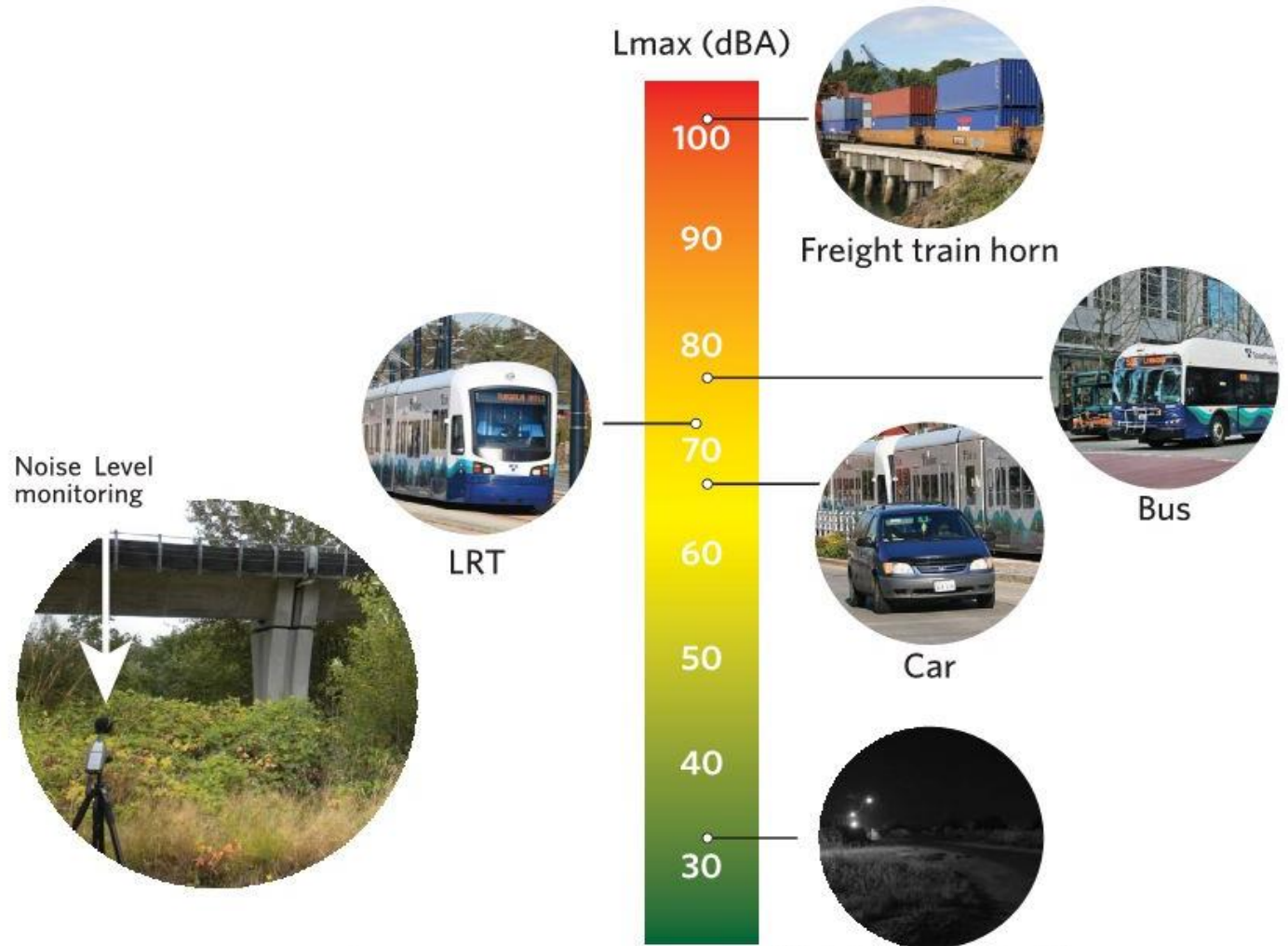




Construction Impacts in the City of SeaTac

- Crossing at S 208th
- Working in collaboration with WSDOT on 509 expansion
