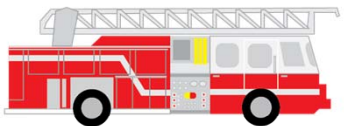

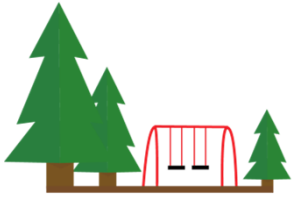

- Became RFA in 2010
- Began contracting with SeaTac in 2014
- 13 Fire Stations (2 in SeaTac)
- 285 full-time firefighters
- 24 hour work schedule
- 26,000 emergency responses in 2018

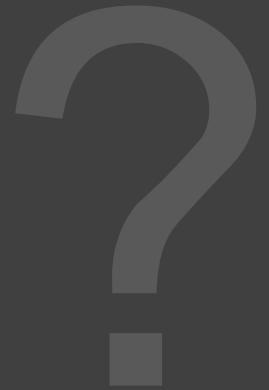
