Agency Presentation(s)

Alisa Kelley, Ruth Dykeman Children and Family Services, works with residents/children/families (children range 5-18 yrs old). Services include case management, advocacy at school or resource linkage. She sees regularly scheduled clients and those in crisis. 90% reach their goals. They've served 27 SeaTac clients equaling 140 therapy sessions who would not have received services due to lack of medical coupons and mental health insurance.

Nathan Phillips, South King Council of Human Services capacity builder works with grant makers; he strengthens the human service system in South King by helping to share trends/pilot projects/new research to work more efficiently and effectively; provides technical assistance on grants, micro consulting, and a bank of volunteer readers to proof grants and advise on how to be more competitive in grant processes. Example: assisted food banks with United Way RFP resulting in \$100,000 increase.
