DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE FILE SEP19-0003

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL: Approximately 2500 cubic yards of cut and approximately 1000 cubic yards of fill material will be used to prepare the site for building construction related to the short subdivision (SUB18-0007) of a 517,296 square foot parcel to be divided into nine single family lots and four tracts. Tract A contains a stormwater facility; Tract B & C labeled "open space" containing critical areas of steep slopes (40% or greater) and two streams (Stream Y Class 3 and Stream Z Class 2 without salmonid presence). All critical areas are contained within the Tracts and buffers have been established in accordance with SMC 15.700 in addition to building setbacks. Tract D contains a private access road. Associated work includes a stormwater outfall and dissipation structure within the buffer of Stream Z as allowed per SMC 15.700.340.E.1. The applicant has committed to alter his design proposal to avoid any additional possible impacts of the stormwater infrastructure in the buffer as shown in plans STE19-0005.
