Agency Presentation(s)

Deb Overlin Feist/Board President and Sandi Schram/Program Director from DAWN shared 134 bednights were provided to 5 SeaTac women and their children; 214 caller received help from the Crisis Line; 135 contacts were made to 5 Latina Community Advocacy Program clients; and 240 hours of service were provided to 24 Community Advocacy Program clients. DAWN's house provides confidential shelter for up to 9 women/16 children per night. DAWN's comprehensive services include: Housing/Transitional Housing/Shelter/Motel Vouchers/Support Groups/Legal Advocacy/Court Accompaniment/Individual Advocacy/Mental Health Counseling/Outreach and Education/24-hour Crisis Line/Outreach to teens. Future goals for DAWN include helping others understand the cycle of Domestic Violence and advocating for a community effort to eliminate the cycle.

John Zumsteg provided an overview of the score sheet/rating tool to be used in the 2011-2012 funding cycle and the committee scored an application.
