INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN SOUTHWEST SUBURBAN SEWER DISTRICT, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON AND THE CITY OF SEA-TAC

WHEREAS, Southwest Suburban Sewer District is a municipal corporation operating a system of sanitary collection and sewer treatment facilities in King County, Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sea-Tac has been incorporated as an official municipality under the laws of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, certain portions of the City of Sea-Tac are within the comprehensive plan of Southwest Suburban Sewer District to provide sanitary sewer service in such areas and at this time the City of Sea-Tac does not wish to provide sanitary sewer service to certain areas within the comprehensive plan area of Southwest Suburban Sewer District; and

WHEREAS, each of the parties will benefit by the provisions of this agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. Southwest Suburban Sewer District shall be authorized to annex the area legally described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth for the provision of sewer service to such properties which lie within the corporate boundaries of the City of Sea-Tac.
- 2. Southwest Suburban Sewer District shall be responsible, either through the use of an extension of the District's present sewer service or by either developer/District extension or by the formation of Utility Local Improvement District for the provision

of such sewer service to the properties located within the area described on Exhibit "A" at no cost to the City of Sea-Tac.

- That all properties to be served in said area shall be billed directly by Southwest Suburban Sewer District for the monthly sewer service charges incurred by making sewer service available to such properties.
- That the cost of improvements for service to said properties shall be borne by such properties and shall not be an indebtedness of the City of Sea-Tac.
- That Southwest District Suburban Sewer shall responsible for maintenance of all such collection and distribution lines as may be necessary to serve said area without charge to the City of Sea-Tac.
- 6. That a memorandum of this agreement may be filed with the King County Boundary Review Board, King County Office of Records and Elections, and any other governmental agency necessary to give notice of this agreement to any affected individual or party.
