# PRESENTATION OVERVIEW

## PURPOSE OF PRESENTATION

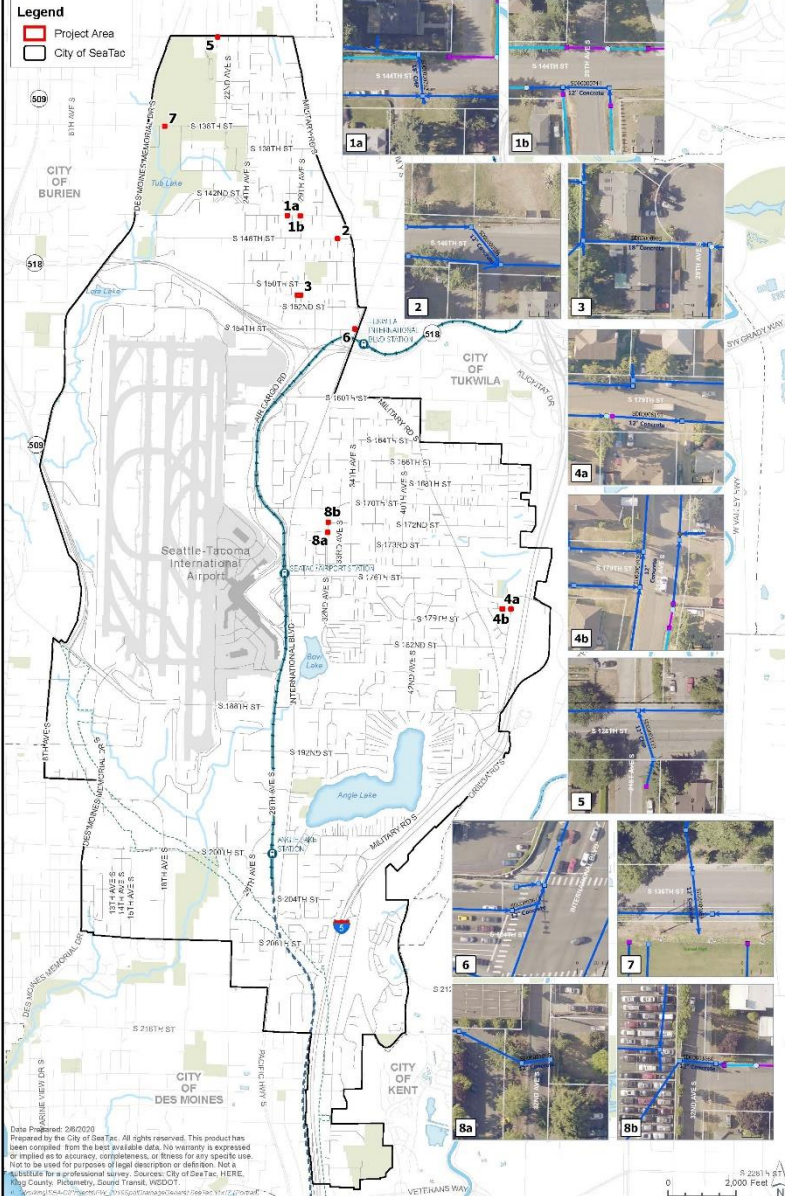
Staff to provide overview of 2019 Spot Drainage Repair Project and request to approve Motion to execute a contract amendment with Blueline for civil engineering design services.

## WHY IS THIS ISSUE IMPORTANT?

1. The 2019 Spot Drainage Repair Project addresses repairs to the stormwater infrastructure at various locations as identified in the Surface Water Management Plan.
2. The recent departure of a Public Works Engineering staff member created a need for civil engineering design services to complete the project design.
3. Additional support was requested to keep the project on schedule to begin construction in 2020.

# AGENDA BILL 5373 OVERVIEW

## PROFESSIONAL CONTRACT WITH BLUELINE EXECUTED ON 12/18/19

- The contract was procured through a competitive process.
- Current contract limited to drafting services only.

## ADDITIONAL SERVICES WARRANTED DUE TO CHANGE IN STAFF

- The original plan was the design to be completed by in-house staff.
- The plan was modified to seek additional support to complete design for construction in 2020.

## FUNDING IS ALLOCATED AND AVAILABLE FOR ADDITIONAL SERVICES

- Funds from 403 Surface Water Management Utility Fund are available to pay for additional services (\$60,400).
- No budget amendment required to pay for additional services.
