- Call 206.973.4555.
  - The public may call in to the conference line to listen to the meeting.
  - While you will be able to hear the meeting; you will not be able to participate in the meeting.
  - Please note that if you are unable to mute your phone, everyone else on the call-in line will be able to hear you, so please refrain from speaking.

### ❖ Join the GoToMeeting to provide remote oral public comment

- Pre-registration is required by 4:00 p.m. the day of the meeting.

- The City Council will not respond to your comments during the meeting. However, if your comments require a response, staff will contact you at a later date using the contact information you provided
- When you have completed your comments, you will be asked to leave the live meeting. However, you may continue to view and/or listen to the live meeting by accessing the options listed above.

### ❖ Submit Written Public Comment

- Written comments will be provided to the City Council and mentioned by name and subject during the meeting.
- Written comments will be placed on the City's website for viewing after the meeting.
- Public comments submitted to an email address other than [PublicComment@seatacwa.gov](mailto:PublicComment@seatacwa.gov), or after the deadline, will not be included as part of the record.
