WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?


- project will construct a new shared pedestrian and bicyclist facility that will extend along the south side of South 200th Street between 12th Pl. S and the Des Moines Creek Trailhead, approximately 3,200 linear feet
- 2. Due to complexity of some aspects of construction and staff workload capacity, staff needs assistance in construction management support.
- 3. Upon Council award, staff will Issue notice to proceed and start construction in September 2020.




PROJECT LOCATION

- S 200th St between 12th PI S and the Des Moines Creek Trailhead.
- Project site is approximately 3,200 LF.

AGENDA BILL OVERVIEW

Construction Contract – Ceccanti Construction

- Project was advertised on July 9, 2020 and bid opening was on August 3, 2020
- City received 13 bids.
- Ceccanti, Inc. was lowest responsible responsive bidder at \$2,129,409.
- Bid was \$77,264 below engineering estimate of \$2,206,673.
- Contract provisions stipulate the City must award contract within 45 days of bid opening.



AGENDA BILL OVERVIEW

Perteet Contract – Construction Management Services

- Publics Works staff interviewed four consulting firms for construction management services.
- Perteet was selected based on interview score and qualifications.
- Professional services to include:
 - Construction administration
 - Material testing
 - Project closeout



AGENDA BILL OVERVIEW

PBS Contract Amendment – Design Support Services

- PBS provided design services for this project
- Proposing to execute an amendment to:
 - a) Extend contract term to December 31, 2021; and
 - b) Expand scope of work to provide design support during construction on as needed basis.
