

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
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	Plan. The draft plan will be brought to the Planning Commission and City Council in September. The draft will be substantially the same as what has been presented to this Committee.


Mockup Drawing - Grandview Park






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

 - Park signage at S. 150th
 - Project maximum allowable construction costs (MACC) \$274,865
 - Construction fully funded by King County Community Development Block Grant awarded in 2019 in the amount of \$338,400



Site Plan


