City of SeaTac, Pete Kang, 4800 S 188th St Seatac, WA 98188-8605, is seeking coverage under the Washington State Department of Ecology's Construction Stormwater NPDES and State Waste Discharge General Permit.

The proposed project, 34th Avenue S, is located at 34th Avenue South between South 166th Street & South 160th Street, South 160th Street between 34th Avenue South & International Blvd, South 161st Street between 34th Avenue South & 32nd Avenue South in SeaTac in King County.

This project involves 1.94 acres of soil disturbance for Highway or Road, Utilities, Other (Pedestrian Facilities) construction activities. The receiving waterbody is the Gilliam Creek System.

Any persons desiring to present their views to the Washington State Department of Ecology regarding this Application, or interested in Ecology's action on this Application, may notify Ecology in writing no later than 30 days of the last date of publication of this notice. Ecology reviews public comments and considers whether discharges from this project would cause a measurable change in receiving water quality, and, if so, whether the project is necessary and in the overriding public interest according to Tier II anti-degradation requirements under WAC 173-201A-320.
