LIBRARY REPORT:

Felicia Wilson joined for her first ACLAC meeting, she is the new regional manager for King County Library Systems. She oversees Valley View, two Federal Way branches and Des Moines. Federal Way is working on programming that will include the use of their new Maker Space. Curbside is still available and online programming. Committee members asked for more details about the maker space in Federal Way, Felicia will bring details about it to next month's meeting.

ARTS AND CULTURE MASTER PLAN UPDATE:

Brian shared a slideshow covering the masterplan. Thoughts for the implementation roadmap documents were shared. The slideshow highlighted a word cloud, which included 'farmers market'. Members asked about the details of starting up a market in SeaTac, potential locations were shared such as the Angle Lake Transit Station, and partnering with Sound Transit. The implementation plan covered engaging different cultures and community members, the committee decided to reach out to various people and put together a list of these people with their contact information. This will lead to better engagement, create a space where they can share cultural happenings in their community and include family and youth in future programs and plans.

CULTURAL CONVERSATION EVENT:

This event was an opportunity to reach out to different organizations in SeaTac, to start a conversation about what they are doing and see if our agendas overlap and work together. The plan is for this group to meet quarterly.
