	Comments: The City's Military Road South Improvements Project has been selected to receive a Washington State Transportation Improvement Board grant in the amount of \$2,950,560.00. The goal of the grant is to promote improved safety and mobility. The project would continue the Military Road South improvements north from South 176 th Street to South 166 th Street. In order to provide city matching funds, the Des Moines Memorial Drive and S 200th Intersection and the Int'l Blvd at SR 518 Interchange Improvement projects would be delayed.

	Comments: Staff presented the South 164 th Street project for consideration as the 2011 Ann Neighborhood Sidewalk Project. The project would extend sidewalk on both sides of South 16 Street from 34 th Avenue South to Military Road. During the 2011-2016 TIP process, the Plann Commission noted that sewer was not available on this portion of South 164 th Street. South 164 th Valley View Sewer District on the possibility of constructing sewer conjunction with the sidewalk project. Valley View petitioned the neighborhood and will forming a ULID to fund the sewer extension. Combining the projects will reduce the over construction cost, and reduce disruption to the neighborhood.
