Pursuant to SMC 16A.13.010, notice is hereby given that the SeaTac Planning Commission will hold a virtual public hearing on May 26, 2021, at 5:30 pm. This hearing will be to receive verbal and written public comment on the following actions:

FILE NUMBER: SeaTac Housing Action Plan/SEP21-0006

PROJECT NAME: SeaTac Housing Action Plan

PROJECT LOCATION: Citywide

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Plan identifies near- and mid-term strategies to promote more housing and housing types for current and future SeaTac residents at all income levels. Recommendations include consideration of amendments to the City's complete communities policies and code amendments related to small lot single family development, cottage housing, and live/work units. Other proposed strategies include the clarification of condominium provisions in the development code, consideration of changes to the minimum lot size in the Urban Low (UL) 7,200 single family zone, a City-initiated program to encourage the re-classification of residential parcels to their highest potential zone, and programmatic activities such as a multi-family parking study.
