Approve Prior Meeting's Minutes	A copy of the 04/01/2021 minutes was provided to the committee for review. The committee approved the minutes as presented.
2. Military Road South 5- Way Intersection Public Open House Review	Informational Only Senior Planner David Tomporowski addressed the committee to provide information on the upcoming online Open House Military Road South Five-Way Intersection Study. The Open House is scheduled to go live on June 2, 2021 and will be available until June 23, 2021. This intersection is located in the northeast part of the city at Military Road South, South 164th and 42nd Avenue South. The purpose of the study is to determine the most efficient and effective long-term configuration to accommodate all modes of travel through the five-legged intersection. A slide show was presented with three different alternatives for a redesigned and rebuilt intersection. The intersection currently has safety issues and operates at capacity during peak periods. Future development is planned in the adjacent intersection area, which will increase pressure on the intersection.

	City staff will be seeking the public's feedback on the different alternatives via the online open house. Postcards advertising the open house will be mailed to residents and businesses within a quarter mile of the intersection ahead of June 2. The City will publicize the open house via various channels, including mailing postcards to the surrounding neighborhoods. A final report and selection of a preferred intersection design is planned for the Summer of 2021.
