Is there a list of vendor equipment or manufacturer SCL prefers?	Unknown should be part of the scope of work
Is there a list of electric vehicles SCL plans to adopt of purchase?	Unknown, City of SeaTac will own the vehicles
Are SCL and PSE working toward a list of standards or preferred operating environment?	Unknown should be part of the scope of work
Is there a breakdown by year of when the electrical vehicles are coming online and quantities forecasted?	Unknown should be part of the scope of work
Are there expected monitoring and reporting of usage that is used to determine PMS preventative maintenance intervals for replacement of equipment?	Unknown should be part of the scope of work
What cost recovery targets are expected by year for operations?	The City of SeaTac wants to understand cost saving or additional cost of an Electric Fleet, based on operational and infrastructure costs
What are the current load forecasts per charged unit expected?	Unknown should be part of the scope of work
What percentage of fuel cell vs battery operating vehicles are forecasted?	Current plan is for 100% Battury fleet for light duty vehicles, would consider options for heavy duty vehicles and equipment
What are the maintenance expectations and training size required for fuel cell vs electric systems deployed?	Unknown should be part of the scope of work
What agencies are already engaged with SCL or PSE to apply grants or funding from?	Unknown
What percentage of MWBE compliance is expected?	The City of SeaTac encourages MWBE companies to apply.
