The City of SeaTac is requesting proposals from qualified consultants to complete the second phase of a two-phase project to update the City Center/Airport District Subarea Plan. Phase 1 of the project ended in early 2020, with the adoption of a new vision and preliminary urban design framework for the District. Phase 2 will result in an updated subarea plan and supportive development code to guide the long term development of the airport business and residential district adjacent to the SeaTac/Airport light rail station and Sea-Tac International Airport.
